Temporary Concrete Safety Barriers to be Installed Along Interstate 805 North Median

Construction crews will install temporary concrete traffic safety barriers (k-rail) overnight beginning next week along the median of Interstate 805 (I-805) in both directions of the freeway between State Route 52 (SR 52) and just north of La Jolla Village Drive. Work to install the barriers will occur between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Tuesday, April 16, through Thursday, April 25. The barriers will be in place along the freeway median for approximately two years during construction on the first phase of the I-805 North Express Lanes Project.

The first phase of construction of the I-805 North Express Lanes Project began in February. The project will add one carpool, or High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV), lane in each direction of I-805 from just south of SR 52 to just north of Mira Mesa Boulevard and build a south facing Direct Access Ramp at Carroll Canyon Road. The carpool lanes are scheduled to open in winter 2015.

During construction, commuters may experience temporary lane closures, reduced shoulders and lane widths, and equipment along the freeway median. Motorists traveling through the construction zone should use extra caution as heavy equipment and trucks will be entering and exiting the median. During construction, travelers are encouraged to slow down, give themselves more time, and anticipate possible traffic delays. To increase motorist safety and improve traffic flow, the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) has expanded its San Diego Freeway Service Patrol program along I-805 to help stranded drivers.
