Construction Notice

Construction is scheduled to begin on the I-805 North Express Lanes Project

Construction on the Interstate 805 (I-805) North Express Lanes Project is scheduled to commence this month. The project covers a distance of approximately four miles, from just south of State Route 52 (SR 52) to just north of Mira Mesa Boulevard in San Diego. Stage 1 construction will add one carpool, or High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV), lane in each direction and build a south facing Direct Access Ramp at Carroll Canyon Road. The carpool lanes are scheduled to open in the winter of 2015.

Construction activities will take place along the median in both directions. Traffic lanes will be shifted slightly, the median will be eliminated from SR 52 to Mira Mesa Boulevard, and a temporary concrete barrier (k-rail) will be installed to protect workers.

Motorists traveling through the construction zone should use extra caution as slow-moving vehicles will be entering and exiting the median. During construction, travelers are encouraged to give themselves more time and anticipate possible traffic delays. To increase motorist safety and improve traffic flow, SANDAG has expanded its San Diego Freeway Service Patrol (FSP) program along I-805 North to help stranded drivers. Night Work

At the onset of construction, there will be temporary night work along the freeway in both directions. The work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, and is expected to take approximately two weeks. During this time, there will also be work on the following freeway ramps:

- · Governor Drive
- · Nobel Drive
- La Jolla Village Drive / Miramar Road
- · Mira Mesa Boulevard
- Vista Sorrento Parkway

Crews will work to minimize impacts to nearby businesses, residents and commuters during construction. We appreciate your patience and will continue to keep you informed throughout construction.
