Project Title: Interstate 805 Managed Lanes South

Project Location: San Diego, Interstate 805, Post Mile 4.4-15.7

Project Description: The proposed project will maintain or improve traffic operations on the I-805 south corridor, from the interchange with SR 905 to the SR 15 Interchange, providing safe and efficient regional movement of people and goods through design year 2030. The project proposes to add managed lanes, direct access ramps, and auxiliary lanes or Single Occupancy Vehicle (SOV) lanes where needed. The proposed project would provide a backbone of multi modal transportation facilities for the I-805 south corridor and would facilitate the use of bus rapid transit and carpools

This is to inform you that the California Department of Transportation will be the lead agency and will prepare an environmental impact report for the project described below. Your participation as a responsible agency is requested in the preparation and review of this document.

We need to know the views of your agency as to the scope and content of the environmental information that is germane to your agency's statutory responsibilities in connection with the proposed project. Your agency will need to use the EIR prepared by our agency when considering your permit or other approval for the project.
