I-805 North Express Lanes Project

Overnight Closures of Mira Mesa Boulevard/Sorrento Valley Road at Interstate 805, November 24th

Crews will close Mira Mesa Boulevard/Sorrento Valley Road at Interstate 805 (I-805) Monday from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. The closure is necessary to safely remove temporary bridge supports and is part of ongoing construction on Stage 1 of the I-805 North Express Lanes Project.

Motorists traveling westbound on Mira Mesa Boulevard will be detoured onto Scranton Road, then westbound on Carroll Canyon Road to Sorrento Valley Road. Motorists traveling eastbound on Sorrento Valley Road will be detoured to Carroll Canyon Road, then northbound on Scranton Road, and back to Mira Mesa Boulevard. Detour signs will be placed to assist motorists through the detour route.

Stage 1 of the I-805 North Express Lanes Project

is constructing one carpool lane in each direction in the median of I-805 from just north of State Route 52 to just north of Mira Mesa Boulevard. The project also includes construction of a Direct Access Ramp to and from southbound I-805 at Carroll Canyon Road. Additional improvements include bridge widening and ramp modifications. This stage is estimated to cost approximately \$86 million.



Caltrans' top priority is safety. Every precaution will be taken to ensure the protection of motorists and

highway workers. Motorists are urged to slow down during construction. Be work zone alert!
