
Overnight Closures Planned Along Interstate 805 in Chula Vista December 15-22

NEARBY RESIDENTS CAN EXPECT INTERMITTENT NOISE AND LIGHTS

A series of overnight closures are planned along Interstate 805 (I-805) between East Orange Avenue/Olympic Parkway and Telegraph Canyon Road in Chula Vista between Tuesday, Dec. 15, and Tuesday, Dec. 22 to accommodate the removal of falsework – temporary supports for bridge construction – at East Palomar Street.

The most significant of these closures will occur between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. on the evenings of Dec. 16, 17, and 20, when all southbound lanes will be closed. During the closures, travelers are urged to avoid the area or take alternate routes. Motorists will be detoured around the closures via Telegraph Canyon Road, Medical Center Drive, Brandywine Avenue, and Olympic Parkway as indicated in the map to the right. Northbound lanes will remain open during this time.

Additional closures of up to three lanes along the same segment of I-805 are planned to further accommodate this work. Tonight, closures are planned along southbound I-805 between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m., and next week, closures are planned along northbound I-805 on Dec. 21 and 22 between 9 p.m. and 4 a.m.



The detour above will be in place along southbound I-805 between East Orange Avenue/Olympic Parkway and Telegraph Canyon Road the evenings of Dec. 16, 17, and 20.

Street can expect intermittent construction noise and lights during these closures. Construction crews will work to minimize impacts to nearby businesses, residents, and commuters. During construction, motorists are reminded to slow down. Not only is it required by law, it helps save lives. We appreciate your patience during construction.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

Construction of the East Palomar Street Direct Access Ramp (DAR) is part of the first phase of the I-805 South Express Lanes Project, a \$1.1 billion effort to create a modern new transportation backbone for South County. Since construction began on Phase 1 in summer 2012, eight miles of new carpool lanes – one in each direction – have been constructed between East Naples Street in Chula Vista and State Route 94 in San Diego. Additionally, construction was completed on 10 sound walls along the route to help lower freeway noise and improve the quality of life for nearby residents.

Construction is currently underway on a Transit Station and Park & Ride adjacent to the planned DAR at East Palomar Street in Chula Vista. Additionally, a northbound auxiliary lane and a southbound outside through lane are under construction along I-805 at East Plaza Boulevard in National City. Weather permitting, the first phase of the I-805 South Express Lanes Project will be completed in early 2016.
