Interstate 805 South Express Lanes Project Progressing

Construction of DAR, Transit Station and Park & Ride at East Palomar Street in Chula Vista Nearing

Construction of a Direct Access Ramp (DAR), Transit Station and Park & Ride at East Palomar Street in Chula Vista is scheduled to begin this spring. Once completed, the project will provide travelers with access to the planned South Bay Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) system, and offer a convenient location from which carpools and vanpools can access the carpool lanes currently under construction on Interstate 805 (I-805). The project is expected to be completed in winter 2014.

To learn more about the project and the upcoming construction on the East Palomar Street DAR, Transit Station and Park & Ride, we encourage you to attend a construction workshop scheduled for Thursday, March 7, 2013 from 6 to 8 p.m. at Palomar Elementary School, located at 300 East Palomar Street in Chula Vista.

Construction of the East Palomar Street DAR, Transit Station and Park & Ride is part of the first phase of the I-805 South Express Lanes Project, a \$1.4 billion effort to create a modern new transportation backbone for the South County. Construction on the first phase of the project began in June. Work includes building one carpool lane in each direction along an eight-mile segment of the freeway stretching from East Palomar Street in Chula Vista to State Route 94 in San Diego. The carpool lanes are scheduled to open in fall 2013.

Significant progress has been made on the first phase of the I-805 South Express Lanes Project. Construction crews recently completed the installation of piles to widen bridges along the freeway median at East Naples Street; Telegraph Canyon Road; Bonita Road; the I-805 and State Route 54 (SR 54) interchange; Sweetwater Road and Euclid Avenue. Work has now begun on the bridge decks. During construction, you can expect temporary lane closures and detours, reduced lane widths, road restriping, some night work and equipment along the freeway median. Lane widths will be restored once work has been completed. Drivers should slow down, allow more time to reach your destination and anticipate possible traffic delays, especially around construction areas.

In an effort to reduce congestion during construction, we encourage you to consider alternative routes to work and school, especially during peak travel periods. One solution is to take the South Bay Expressway. Use the South Bay Expressway for an easy, stress-free commute to downtown, Sorrento Valley, Santee, Interstate 8 and Interstate 15, Otay Mesa, Mexico and more.

All reasonable steps will be taken to minimize impacts to nearby residents, commuters and travelers during construction on the I-805 South Express Lanes Project. We appreciate your patience!


