Starting Monday: *Rapid* 237

The *Rapid* network of transit service with fast and convenient connections to work, school, entertainment, and shopping is expanding! *Rapid* 237 will offer weekday peak-period service between Rancho Bernardo and UC San Diego, with stops at Sabre Springs and along Mira Mesa Boulevard, and connections to SuperLoop at Genesee Avenue/UTC and the Gilman Transit Center. *Rapid* 215 service starts Monday, October 13 and will operate every 15 minutes from 5:30 – 10:30 a.m. and 2-7 p.m. Rides on *Rapid* 237 will be FREE all day on Monday, October 13 to celebrate the launch of the new route. Gilman Transit Center

Construction of the Gilman Transit Center began on the UC San Diego campus in June 2014 and opened to riders on September 15. The center serves campus shuttles, NCTD Route 101, MTS routes 30, 41, 150, and 921, [SuperLoop](#) Routes 201 and 202, and the new *Rapid* 237. Work related to permanent lighting, railings, transit shelters, and additional landscaping will continue through winter 2014/2015. Once completed, the new transit center will include bus turnouts for efficient loading of passengers, four new bus stations (two of which incorporate SuperLoop branding and next bus arrival signs), larger waiting areas for bus riders, improved seating and lighting, a dedicated bike lane, and open space improvements.
