

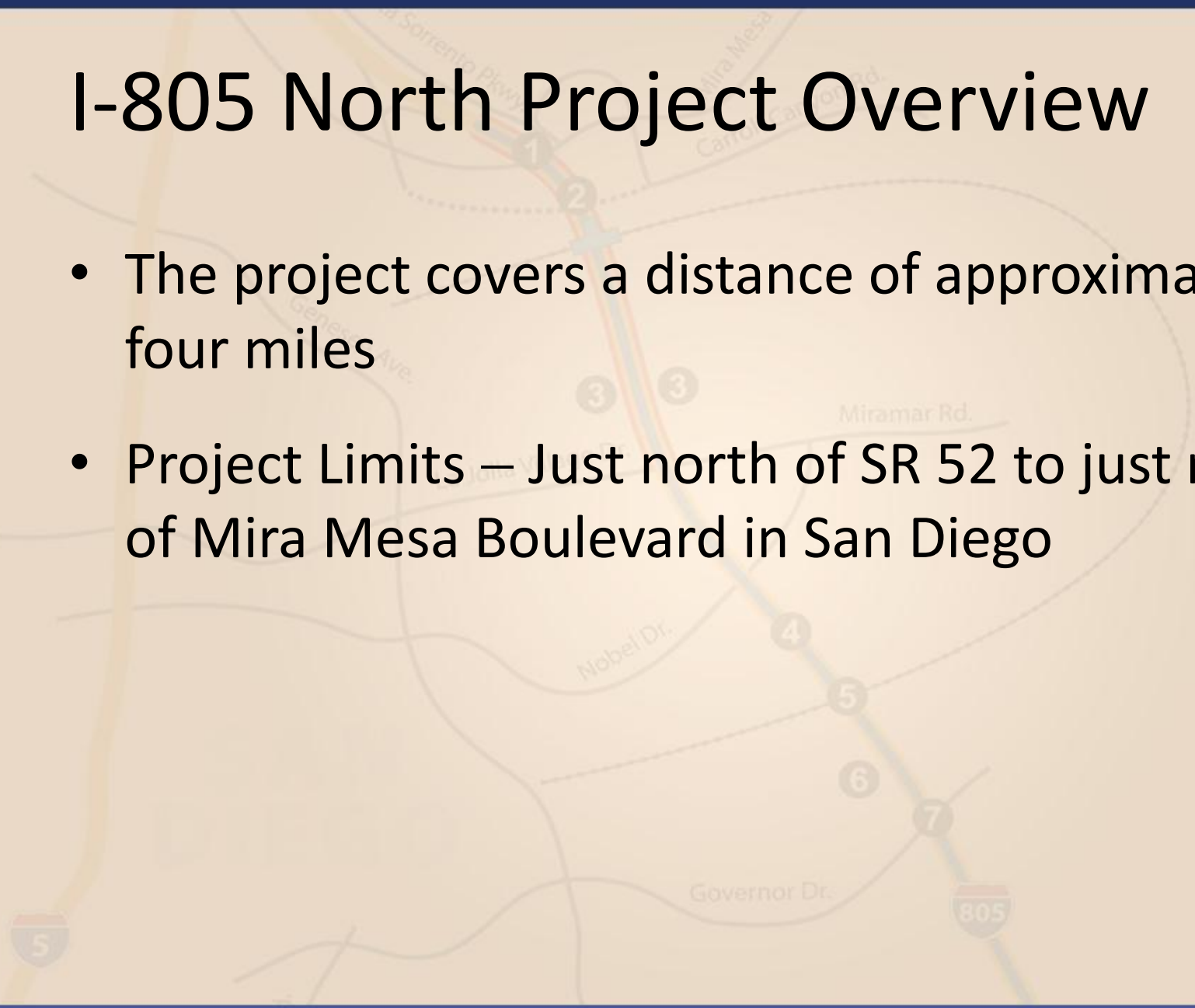

# I-805 North Project Overview

- The project covers a distance of approximately four miles
- Project Limits – Just north of SR 52 to just north of Mira Mesa Boulevard in San Diego



# I-805 North Project Overview

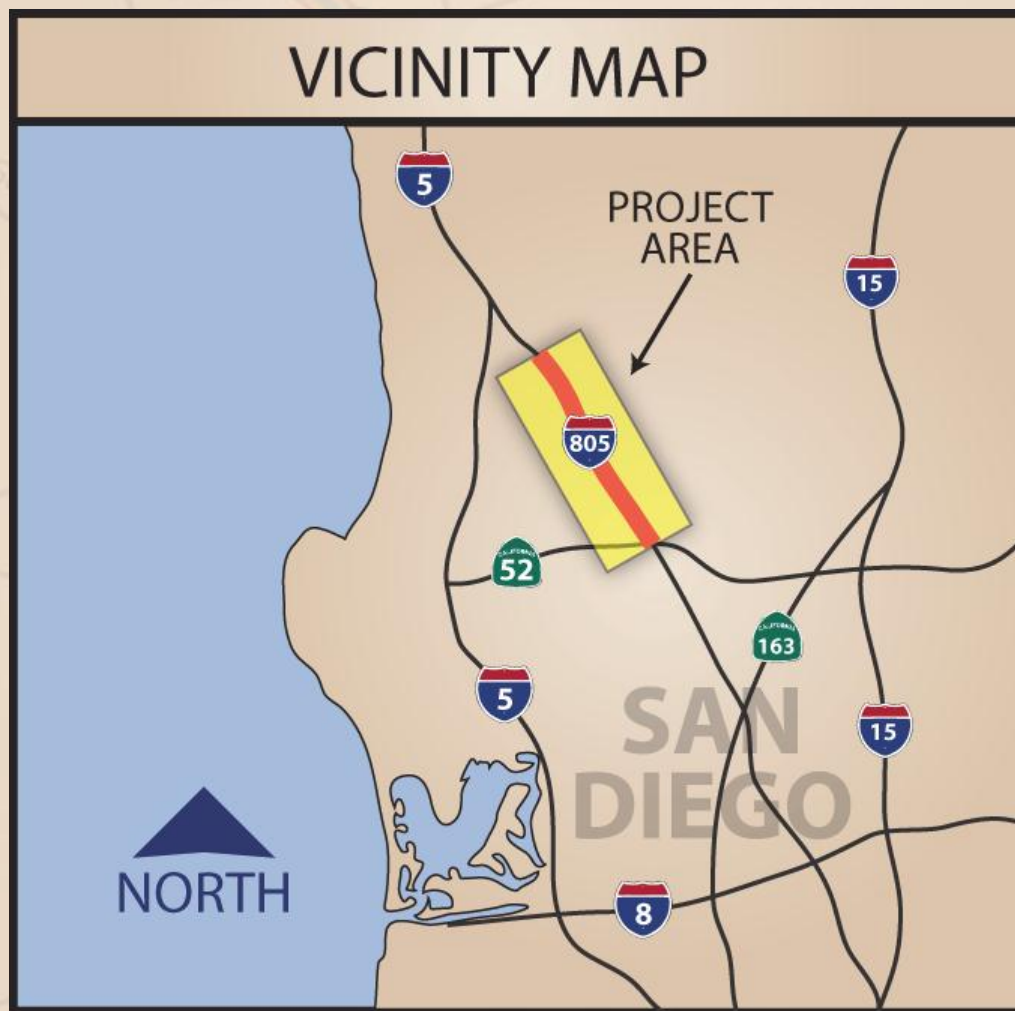
The five-stage project will widen the freeway to accommodate:

- Four carpool, or High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV), lanes from SR 52 to La Jolla Village Drive
- Two carpool lanes from La Jolla Village Drive to just north of Mira Mesa Boulevard
- Direct Access Ramp (DAR) at Nobel Drive
- Park & Ride and Transit Station at Nobel Drive
- South facing DAR at Carroll Canyon Road
- Direct freeway-to-freeway connector
  - WB SR 52 to NB I-805
  - SB I-805 to EB SR 52

# Stage 1 – Project Elements

- Construct one carpool lane in each direction, from SR 52 to just north of Mira Mesa Boulevard
- Construct south facing Direct Access Ramp (DAR) at Carroll Canyon Road
- Bridge widenings
- Ramp modifications
- Noise barrier modifications

Two inside carpool lanes from SR 52 to just north of Mira Mesa Blvd.



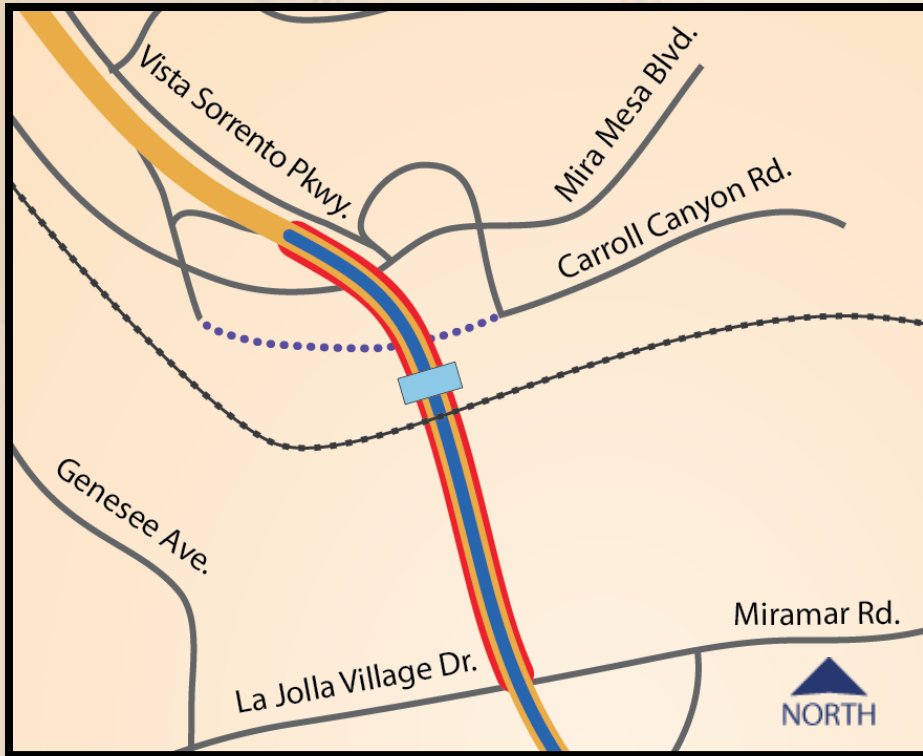




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# Governor Drive

Undercrossing (median widening)

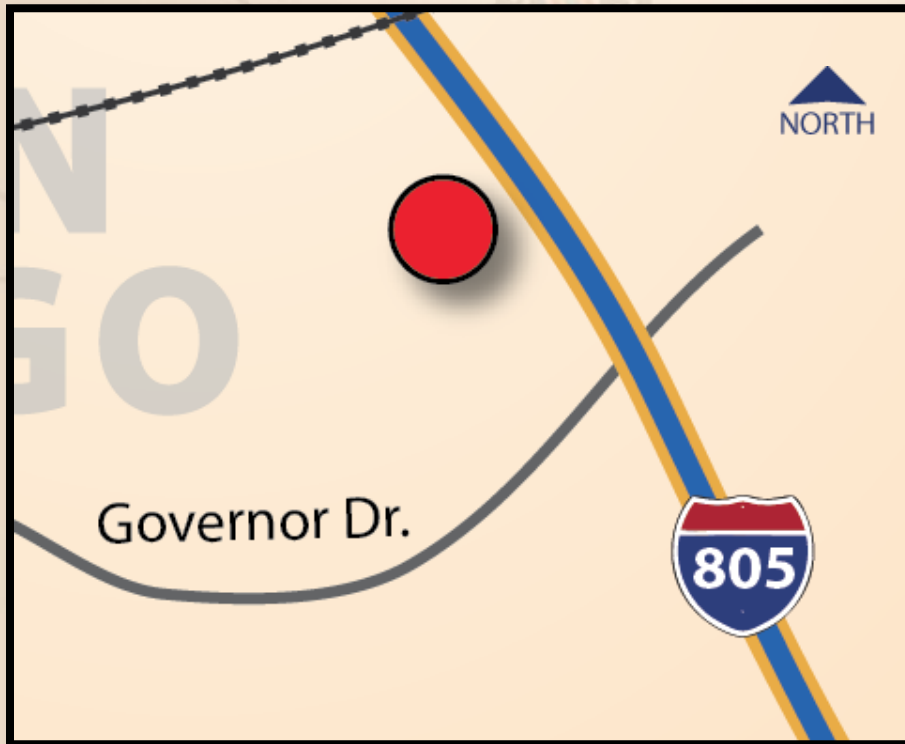


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

southbound off-ramp

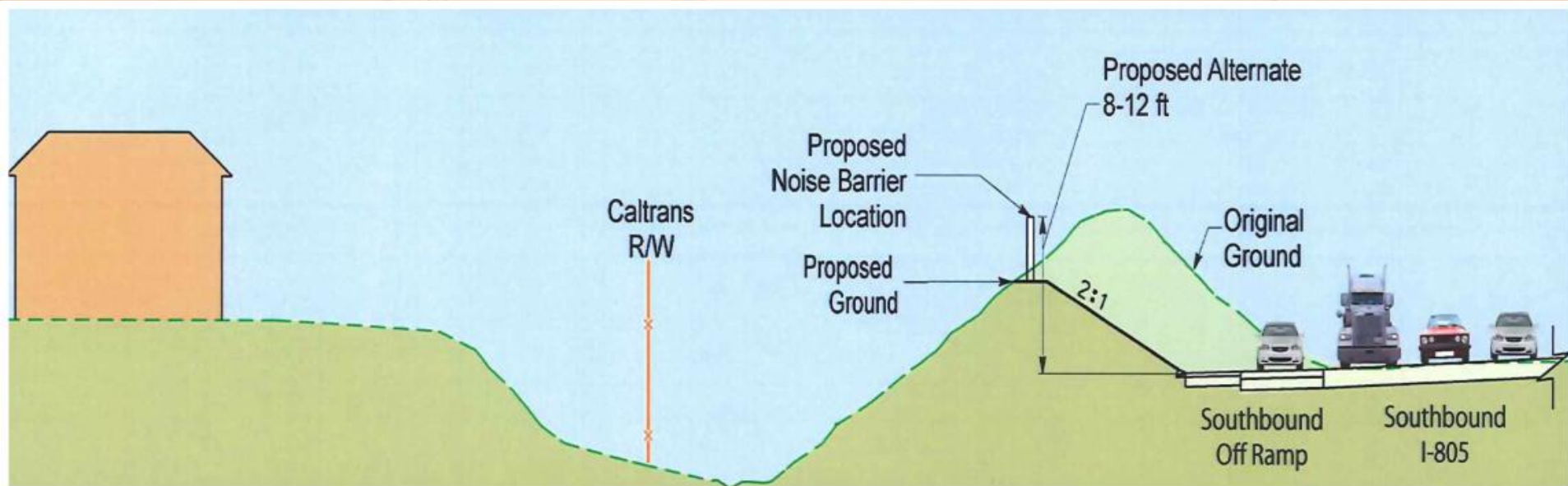


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




# Rose Canyon

Overhead bridge (median widening)

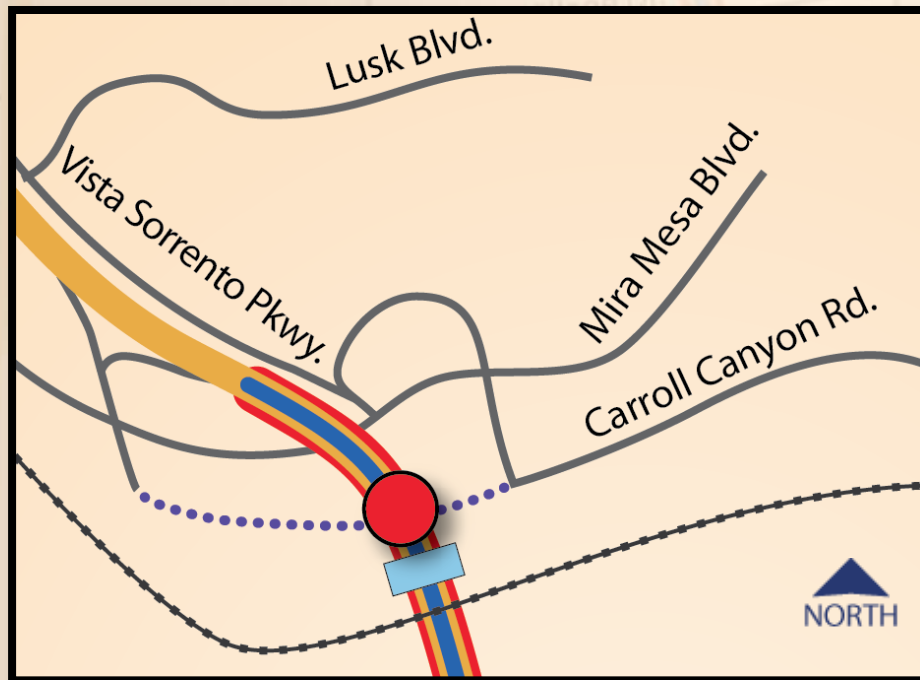



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# Carroll Canyon Road

- DAR Walls

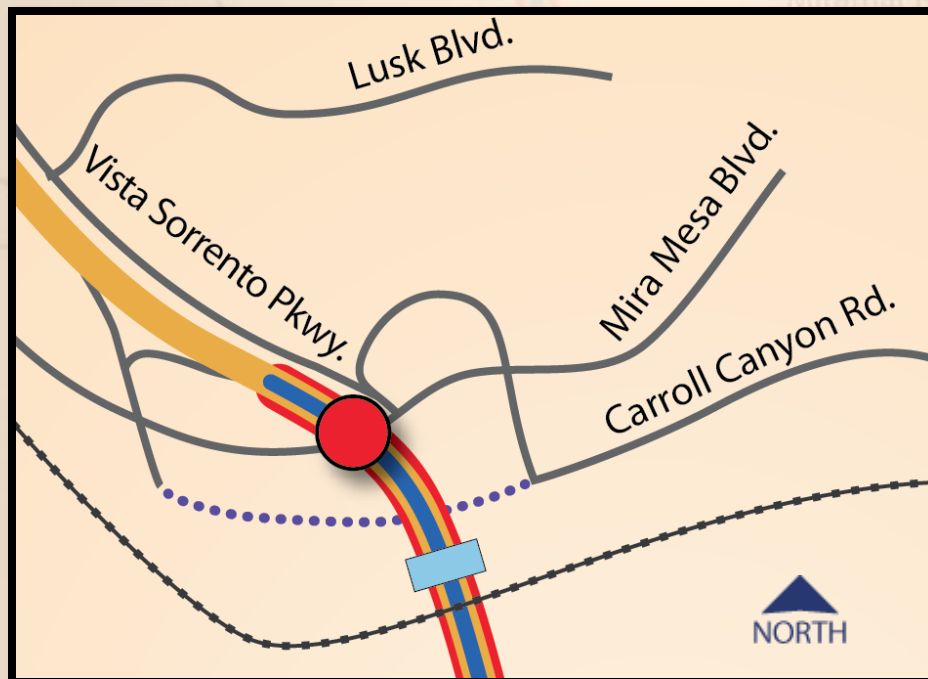


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


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# Mira Mesa Boulevard

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# What You Should Expect

- Slow moving equipment moving in and out of the work zone (shoulder and median)
- Series of extended ramp closures
- Night-time lane and ramp closures to set K-rail
- Traffic shifts over the life of the project between inside and outside lanes
- Impacts to local streets in the project vicinity
