 - a. **Application No. 9-19-1250 (City of Santa Barbara Desalination Facility)**
Application of City of Santa Barbara to relocate existing weir box, associated pipelines and fittings, and erosion protection serving as part of the City desalination facility's intake structure, on East Beach in Santa Barbara, Santa Barbara County. (TL-SF)
11. **FEDERAL CONSISTENCY**
 - a. **CC-0004-18 (SANDAG, San Diego Co)** Consistency Certification modifications for Del Mar Bluffs Stabilization Project 4 concurred with by the Commission in February 2019. Project modifications include increasing height of existing retaining wall by 3 feet at toe of the bluff near 12th St., installing 4 additional soldier piles on upper bluff near 12th St., and repairing small upper bluff failure near 7th St., San Diego County. (LS-SF)

Alternatively, you may also submit such materials directly to the Commissioners (a current list of Commissioner names and email addresses is available from Commission staff or from the Commission's website) as long as such materials are submitted to all Commissioners, all alternates for Commissioners, the three non-voting members of the Commission, and Commission staff. You are requested to summarize the reasons for your position in no more than two or three pages, if possible.
