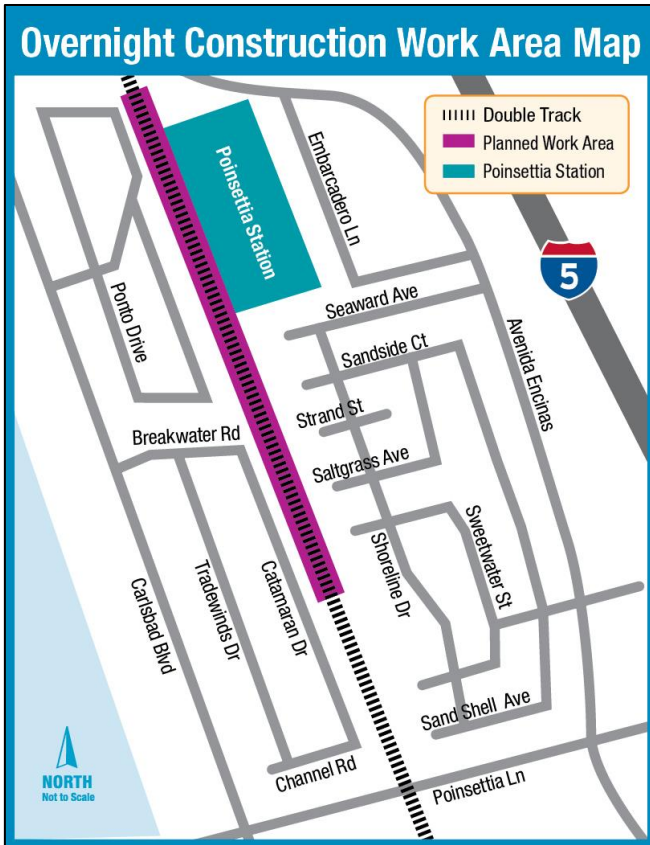


## Poinsettia Station Improvements Project Update


### Overnight Construction Planned for the Next Three Weeks at Poinsettia Station



As part of the Poinsettia Station Improvements Project, construction crews will perform overnight track work during the weeks of September 8, September 15, and September 22, in the City of Carlsbad.

**This work will occur on weeknights only**, starting on Monday night and continuing each weeknight until Saturday morning, **between the hours of 9 p.m. – 5 a.m.** Crews will work between the double tracked rail line both north and south of the station platform, with overnight construction activities consisting of intertrack fence installation. This overnight work is necessary as one or both tracks will be taken out of service to ensure the safety of crew members working between the tracks, and will reduce daytime train service interruptions.

Nearby residents can **expect nighttime work hours, construction noise, and lights from these construction activities**, which include [Occupational Safety and Health Administration \(OSHA\) required vehicle back-up alarms](#). Residents also can expect to see construction equipment and vehicles moving in and out of the work areas. Crews will work to minimize noise and other construction-related impacts to surrounding residents. **Please note, construction schedules and activities are subject to change.** Thank you for your patience during construction.






### TRAIN HORN RULES

Federal regulations require the train engineer to sound the horn when approaching an active construction site, even in a quiet zone. Train horns serve as a warning system to ensure the safety of railroad workers.
