

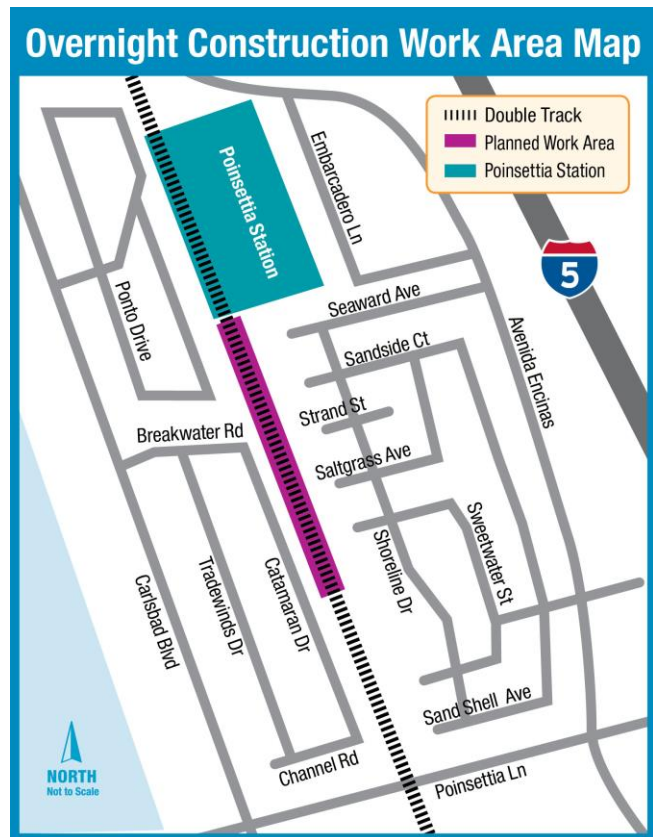
Overnight Construction Planned at Poinsettia Station

Wednesday, July 17 – 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

As part of the Poinsettia Station Improvements Project, construction crews will perform overnight track work on **Wednesday, July 17, from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.**, in the City of Carlsbad. This work will occur south of the station platform on the new eastern track, and overnight construction activities will consist of rail cutting, grinding, and welding operations.

Nearby residents can expect **nighttime work hours, construction noise, and lights from these activities**, which include [Occupational Safety and Health Administration \(OSHA\) required vehicle back-up alarms](#). Crews will work to minimize noise and other impacts to surrounding residents. Residents near the site can also expect to see construction equipment and vehicles moving in and out of work areas.

Please note, construction schedules and activities are subject to change. Thank you for your patience during construction.



TRAIN HORN RULES

Federal regulations require the train engineer to sound the horn when approaching an active construction site, even in a quiet zone. Train horns serve as a warning system to ensure the safety of railroad workers.
