Crews have finished track work for the Control Point (CP) Rose Crossovers Project and are now performing minor activities to reestablish vegetation in the area. As part of the next phase of construction on the project, storm drain installation work will begin in mid-June 2016 and continue until early August 2016. Work hours will be during the day, Monday through Friday, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Crews will minimize impacts as much as possible.

San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) is working to improve efficiency, add passengers, and increase the number of trains on the San Diego segment of the Los Angeles-San Diego-San Luis Obispo (LOSSAN) coastal rail corridor. SANDAG has begun the CP Rose track crossovers project, an element of the Elvira to Morena Double Track Project, to make improvements on the railway behind Regents Road, where the road ends, south of Arriba Street. This phase of the project is anticipated to be completed in summer 2016.
