Nighttime Closure of Northbound I-15 at SR 76

Please be advised that the northbound I-15 at SR 76 will be closed Wednesday, August 14 from 10 p.m. to 4 a.m. I-15 motorists will exit at the SR 76 off-ramps, cross over SR 76 and re-enter I-15.

This closure will allow crews to join the existing SR 76 bridge segment to the new bridge with a smooth, continuous deck surface and install traffic sensors on I-15.

The loop on-ramps from SR 76 to I-15 will be open with flaggers directing traffic.

In addition, on Thursday, August 15, lanes on northbound and southbound I-15 will be closed intermittently as crews install electronic message signs as part of the I-15/SR 76 Interchange improvement project.

We appreciate your continued patience as we complete these improvements. This work is part of the final segment in a series of three improvement projects on the SR 76 corridor, located between I-5 and I-15. Stretching 5.2 miles from South Mission Road to I-15, the SR 76 East Segment serves local and regional traffic.
