Nighttime Closures of Southbound I-15 Off- and On-ramps at I-15/SR 76 Interchange: April 9 & 10*

SR 76 and I-15 will remain open. Please note that you may experience delays within this work area.

Night Closure and Detour

For your safety, the off-ramp from southbound I-15 to SR 76 and the on-ramp from SR 76 to southbound I-15 will be closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Tuesday, April 9 and Wednesday, April 10. Crews will be preparing to re-direct traffic from the temporary ramps to the new permanent ramps, as part of the widening and upgrading of the I-15/SR 76 interchange. I-15 and SR 76 will remain open, as will all other ramps.

Those traveling on the southbound I-15 who want to exit at SR 76 will be directed to exit at Mission Road, or can continue past the closure and exit at Old Highway 395. Either way, drivers will need to travel on Old Highway 395 toward SR 76.

On Wednesday night only, traffic on the SR 76 bridge will be reduced to one lane with a flagger directing traffic.

The SR 76 East Segment is the final segment in a series of three improvement projects on the SR 76 corridor, located between I-15 and I-5. Stretching 5.2 miles from South Mission Road to I-15, the SR 76 East Segment serves local and regional traffic.
