Nighttime Lane and Ramp Closures at I-15 / SR 76 Interchange: April 17 and 18 $^{\circ}$


For your safety, the following ramp and lane closures are taking place on the nights of April 17 and 18 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 17 The off-ramp from the northbound I-15 to SR 76 will be closed as crews complete the construction of the new off-ramp. During the closure, those traveling northbound on I-15 can exit before this off-ramp at Old Highway 395, or drive past the closure to Mission Road to access SR 76. **SR 76 and I-15 will remain open.**

THURSDAY, APRIL 18 Traffic on northbound and southbound I-15 will be reduced to one lane as crews prepare to take down the temporary wood and steel structure that has supported bridge construction for the widening and upgrading of the I-15/SR 76 interchange. **SR 76 and I-15 will remain open, with reduced lanes on I-15.**

Please note that you may experience delays. Changeable message signs will be placed in advance of the closures to alert motorists of the work ahead. We appreciate your continued patience as we complete these improvements.
