Overnight traffic shift at the SR 76 / I-15 Interchange on June 25 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

From Tuesday, June 25 at 9 p.m. to Wednesday, June 26 at 5 a.m., crews will shift traffic into a new configuration that will direct motorists to new on-ramps from SR 76 to I-15.

Starting Tuesday Night:

For Motorists Traveling Eastbound on SR 76

- To access I-15 south, motorists will now need to turn left onto the new southbound on-ramp to I-15
- To access I-15 north, motorists will now travel across the bridge and make a right turn onto the new northbound on-ramp to I-15

For Motorists Traveling Westbound on SR 76

- To access I-15 south, motorists will now travel across the bridge and make a right turn onto the new southbound on-ramp to I-15
- To access I-15 north, motorists will now make a left turn onto the new northbound on-ramp to I-15

We appreciate your continued patience as we complete these improvements. This work is part of the final segment in a series of three improvement projects on the SR 76 corridor, located between I-5 and I-15. Stretching 5.2 miles from South Mission Road to I-15, the SR 76 East Segment serves local and regional traffic.
