Overnight traffic shift at the SR 76/I-15 Interchange on July 11 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

From Thursday, July 11 at 9 p.m. to Friday, July 12 at 5 a.m., crews will shift SR 76 traffic from the north side of the SR 76/I-15 Interchange bridge to the newly widened south side.

All SR 76 traffic—east and westbound—will now travel on the south side of the bridge so that crews can prepare for repaying the north side. This will not affect on- and off-ramps at the interchange. This traffic switch is scheduled to remain in effect until construction is completed in September.

We appreciate your continued patience as we complete these improvements. This work is part of the final segment in a series of three improvement projects on the SR 76 corridor, located between I-5 and I-15. Stretching 5.2 miles from South Mission Road to I-15, the SR 76 East Segment serves local and regional traffic.
