San Diego River Bridge Project

About the Project

San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) is working to improve efficiency and flexibility of trains on the San Diego segment of the Los Angeles-San Diego-San Luis Obispo (LOSSAN) coastal rail corridor. Since last summer, SANDAG has been working to make improvements to the railroad corridor along the San Diego River Bridge portion between Taylor Street and Tecolote Road.

Upcoming Construction Work

Starting February 2016, crews will begin clearing vegetation in and immediately adjacent to the railroad right-of-way in preparation for project construction. This work will include chainsaw and lawnmower operation in and around the railroad corridor. Crews will work to minimize the impact of noise to neighboring businesses and residences as much as possible. Some temporary traffic controls may be in place while work is being completed.

Schedule

Vegetation clearing work will begin in February 2016 and is anticipated to be complete in spring 2016. Daytime work hours are Monday through Friday, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Due to the nature and location of this project, some weekend work hours may be required.
