I-805 North Express Lanes Project

Overnight Closures of Mira Mesa Boulevard/Sorrento Valley Road at Interstate 805, June 8 – June 12

Construction crews will close all lanes on Mira Mesa Boulevard/Sorrento Valley Road at Interstate 805 (I-805) from Sunday, June 8 to Thursday, June 12 from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. The closure is required to erect falsework, a temporary bridge support system used during construction.

Motorists traveling westbound on Mira Mesa Boulevard will be detoured onto Scranton Road, where signs will direct them to travel westbound on Carroll Canyon Road to Sorrento Valley Road. Motorists traveling eastbound on Sorrento Valley Road will be detoured on Carroll Canyon Road to Scranton Road and back on to Mira Mesa Boulevard. Electronic message signs are in place along Mira Mesa Boulevard and detour signs will be placed near the work area to assist motorists around the closure.

The work is part of Stage 1 of the I-805 North Express Lanes Project. The project will construct one carpool lane in each direction in the median of I-805 from just north of SR 52 to just north of Mira Mesa Boulevard. The project will also construct a south-facing Direct Access Ramp to and from I-805 at Carroll Canyon Road. Estimated cost for this stage is \$86 million.
