Sorrento Valley Double Track Project **Nears Completion**

Project Creates Additional 71 Spaces for Commuters

SANDAG is excited to announce the North Lot at the Sorrento Valley COASTER station is now open after construction crews successfully completed drainage, electrical, and landscaping improvements. The lot reopened on schedule on July 1. Along with the new 81-space South Lot that opened in October 2014, there is now a total of 189 parking spaces available to serve transit riders at the Sorrento Valley COASTER station.



The North Lot reopened on July 1.

New Double Track Section Now in Service

SANDAG opened the project's one-mile section of new double track this spring. The double track was completed during a recent Absolute Work Window, when rail traffic was suspended to accommodate construction throughout the coastal rail corridor.



New double track opened to rail service on May 4.

To date, almost two-thirds of the San Diego segment of the LOSSAN rail corridor has been double tracked. which allows trains traveling in opposite directions to pass without slowing down or stopping. Over the next 20 years, SANDAG plans to invest more than \$1 billion to give operators the capacity to add more trains to their schedules and give the region more convenient and reliable choices for travel.

About the Project

In addition to the parking lot and double track improvements, SANDAG has worked in collaboration with the North County Transit District to replace two wooden trestle bridges, originally built in the 1940s, with new concrete structures. Necessary retaining walls were built adjacent to the tracks near the parking lots. Additionally, an embankment protection system was installed on the western side of the track, adjacent to Los Peñasquitos Creek. The project is estimated to be completed in late 2015.
