## Trolley Station Construction & Detours



## Construction at Orange Line Trolley Track Crossings

### September - October 2014

Construction work, including track and asphalt replacement, will occur this fall at the trolley track crossings located at the intersections of Central Avenue & Main Street, and North Avenue & Lemon Grove Avenue. Noise and dust is anticipated during construction and crews will minimize impacts as much as possible.

Work at the **Central Avenue & Main Street** intersection is scheduled from 10 p.m. on Friday, September 12 through 6 a.m. on Monday, September 15.

Work at the **North Avenue & Lemon Grove Avenue** intersection is scheduled from 10 p.m. on Friday, October 10 through 6 a.m. on Monday, October 13.

This construction will involve the use of heavy equipment that will generate intermittent noise and traffic impacts. Traffic control measures will be in place at the trolley crossings.

Local businesses and pedestrian walkways near the crossings will remain accessible. The schedule may change with very little notice. We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the Trolley system.



Please use **extra caution** during construction and follow the direction of the on-site flagging staff when traveling near the work area.

### The Trolley Renewal Project

The Trolley Renewal Project is a joint project of the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) and the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System (MTS). Once complete, new low-floor Trolleys will operate throughout the system. All stations will be equipped with next-arrival signs, new shelters, and seating. The end result will be easier access, quicker trips, a more comfortable ride, and an enhanced transit experience. This work is part of a \$660 million project to renew the entire MTS Trolley network. Funding for the project was provided by *TransNet*, the regional half-cent sales tax for transportation administered by SANDAG; California Proposition 1A and 1B; and the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.
