

Poinsettia Station Improvements Project Update

Saturday Construction Planned for the Next Four Weeks at Poinsettia Station

As part of the Poinsettia Station Improvements Project, construction crews will perform weekend work during the next four Saturdays, **September 21 & 28, and October 5 & 12, from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.** in the City of Carlsbad. Crews will continue retaining wall construction on both the eastern and western sides of the station, electrical, fiber optic, fence and related activities for the new Poinsettia Station pedestrian undercrossing.

Nearby residents can **expect construction noise and lights from these construction activities**, which include [Occupational Safety and Health Administration \(OSHA\) required vehicle back-up alarms](#). Residents also can expect to see construction equipment and vehicles moving in and out of the work areas. Crews will work to minimize noise and other construction-related impacts to surrounding residents. **Please note, construction schedules and activities are subject to change.**
