I-805 North Express Lanes Project



August 2014

Overnight Closure of Northbound Interstate 805 from Nobel Drive to Mira Mesa Boulevard, Thursday, August 28

All lanes on northbound Interstate 805 (I-805) will be closed between Nobel Drive and Mira Mesa Boulevard on August 28 beginning at 9:30 p.m. and reopening at 5 a.m. The closure is required as part of ongoing bridge widening work.

Motorists traveling north on I-805 will be redirected to westbound State Route 52 (SR 52), then to northbound Interstate 5 (I-5). Local traffic will be allowed to exit at Governor Drive and Nobel Drive. Motorists intending to travel north on I-805 from La Jolla Village Drive/Miramar Road, Nobel Drive, and Governor Drive will be detoured to southbound I-805, then to westbound SR 52, then northbound I-5. Detour signs will be placed to assist motorists around the closure.

The work is part of Stage 1 of I-805 North Express Lanes Project. The project will construct one carpool lane in each direction in the median of I-805 from just north of State Route 52 to just north of Mira Mesa Boulevard. The project will also construct a Direct Access Ramp to and from southbound I-805 at Carroll Canyon Road. Additional improvements include bridge widening and ramp modifications. This stage is estimated to cost approximately \$86 million.
