

Overnight Closures of Southbound Interstate 805 From Mira Mesa Boulevard to Governor Drive, April 8-10

Construction crews will close all lanes on southbound Interstate 805 (I-805) from Mira Mesa Boulevard to Governor Drive from April 8 to 10, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. The lane closures are required to accommodate work to widen the Rose Canyon Bridge.

Motorists will be detoured to southbound I-5, then eastbound on SR 52 to northbound or southbound I-805. Electronic message signs are in place along I-805 and detour signs will be placed near the work area to assist motorists around the closure.

The work is part of Stage 1 of the I-805 North Express Lanes Project. The project will construct one carpool lane in each direction in the median of I-805 from just north of SR 52 to just north of Mira Mesa Boulevard. The project will also construct a south-facing Direct Access Ramp to and from I-805 at Carroll Canyon Road. Estimated cost for this stage is \$86 million.
