### San Elijo Lagoon Double Track Project

# Soil Testing and Utility Location Work Planned December 14-18

SANDAG will conduct soil testing work along the railroad tracks between Cardiff-by-the-Sea and Solana Beach next week in advance of a future double track project. Activities will include drilling in multiple locations within the railroad right-of-way. Additional work will occur at the intersection of Chesterfield Drive and San Elijo Avenue to locate underground utilities.

The work will occur between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Nearby businesses and residents can expect some intermittent traffic impacts on Chesterfield Drive, but no detours are planned. Crews will minimize noise and other impacts to the greatest extent possible. Thank you for your patience.

### **About the Project**

The San Elijo Lagoon Double Track Project will add 1.5 miles of new double track from Cardiff-by-the-Sea to the southern border of the San Elijo Lagoon, replace the wooden trestle bridge over the San Elijo Lagoon with a modern concrete bridge, construct a new pedestrian undercrossing at the south end of the lagoon, and improve the signal and at-grade crossing at Chesterfield Drive.

#### **About LOSSAN**

SANDAG is working in collaboration with the North County Transit District to construct approximately \$1 billion in improvements in the San Diego segment of the LOSSAN (Los Angeles-San Diego-San Luis Obispo) rail corridor over the next 20 years. This includes a primary effort to double track the corridor from Orange County to Downtown San Diego, which allows trains traveling in opposite directions to pass without slowing down or stopping. The rail enhancements are part of a balanced set of transportation, environmental, and coastal access projects in the North Coast Corridor.
