



NIGHTTIME FULL CLOSURES OF WASHINGTON STREET

On Tuesday, November 17 and Wednesday, November 18, full closures will be in place on Washington Street for crews to complete work on underground communication and electrical systems at the railroad crossing. During the closures, crews also will repave Washington Street. Traffic controls and detour routes will be posted. Please heed all traffic signs and use caution when traveling near the work area.

What to Expect

- Full closure of the eastbound and westbound lanes on Washington Street between Hancock Street and Frontage Road
- Work and closure hours will be from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night
- Crews will minimize impacts as much as possible

Construction schedules are subject to change.




About the Mid-Coast Trolley Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend UC San Diego Blue Line Trolley service from the Santa Fe Depot in Downtown San Diego to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
