



FULL CLOSURES OF GENESEE AVENUE FOR TROLLEY STATION CONSTRUCTION

Beginning Sunday, January 26, a series of nighttime full closures will go into effect on northbound and southbound Genesee Avenue, between La Jolla Village Drive and Executive Drive. During the closures, crews will form the pedestrian bridges for the future Executive Drive Trolley Station in addition to removing falsework—or temporary support structures—from the Trolley bridge.

Traffic controls and detour routes will be posted. Motorists should take alternate routes to avoid potential congestion. Please heed all traffic signs and use caution when traveling near the work area.

What to Expect:

Beginning Sunday, January 26 through Thursday, January 30, and continuing Sunday, February 2 through Thursday, February 6:

- Full closure of southbound Genesee Avenue between Executive Drive and La Jolla Village Drive from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night
- Full closure of northbound Genesee Avenue between La Jolla Village Drive and Executive Drive from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night


Construction schedules are subject to change.


















About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend UC San Diego Blue Line Trolley service from the Santa Fe Depot in Downtown San Diego to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
