# MID-COAST TROLLEY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

## FULL CLOSURE OF EXECUTIVE DRIVE

Beginning Sunday, January 17 and continuing through Tuesday, January 19, a full closure of Executive Drive will be in place just east of its intersection with Genesee Avenue. During the closure, crews will demolish the roadway and pour concrete to remove and replace a cross gutter. Concrete cross gutters are installed at the intersection of two roadways to help maintain drainage.

### What to Expect

- Full closure of westbound and eastbound lanes on Executive Drive just east of its intersection with Genesee Avenue
- A single lane closure will be in place on northbound Genesee Avenue at the intersection with Executive Drive during the daytime on Monday
- Work and closure hours will be from 7 p.m. on Sunday through 3 p.m. on Tuesday
- Detour routes and signage will be in place; please heed all traffic signs and use caution when traveling near the work area

## About the Mid-Coast Trolley Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend UC San Diego Blue Line Trolley service from the Santa Fe Depot in Downtown San Diego to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
