MID-COAST TROLLEY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

CLOSURES OF SOUTHBOUND GENESEE AVENUE AND THE GENESEE AVENUE/LA JOLLA VILLAGE DRIVE INTERSECTION

Beginning Sunday, September 27, a full closure of southbound Genesee Avenue will be in effect from Executive Drive to the UTC Transit Center, for crews to widen the roadway. Work will include demolition, restriping, and setting K-rail as well as installing railing and performing exterior finish work on the Trolley bridge. Additionally, crews will construct a single bus pad—a durable surface area used to protect asphalt roadways—for the new Metropolitan Transit System bus stop located near Esplanade Court. While work is underway, there also will be a partial closure of the intersection of Genesee Avenue and La Jolla Village Drive.

Traffic controls and detour routes will be posted. Motorists should take alternate routes to avoid potential congestion. Please heed all traffic signs and use caution when traveling near the work area.

What to Expect:

- Work and closure hours will be from Sunday, September 27 at 6 p.m. through Tuesday, September 29 at noon
- Full closure of southbound Genesee Avenue between Executive Drive and the UTC Transit Center
- Closure of eastbound and westbound access at the Genesee Avenue and La Jolla Village Drive intersection on Sunday, September 27 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- As work progresses, crews will reopen a single lane on southbound Genesee Avenue

Construction schedules are subject to change.


About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend UC San Diego Blue Line Trolley service from the Santa Fe Depot in Downtown San Diego to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
