MID-COAST TROLLEY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

UPCOMING PARTIAL INTERSECTION CLOSURES ON GENESEE AVENUE FOR TROLLEY BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION

This February, partial intersection closures will continue along Genesee Avenue in support of the Trolley bridge construction. Crews will be constructing the Trolley bridge, also known as a viaduct, that will carry the Trolley down the middle of Genesee Avenue. Crews will be installing aerial pre-cast girders, which are large beams used to support the Trolley alignment, and supported by the columns to build the viaduct.

Crews have now placed girders in five intersections along Genesee Avenue. The following partial closure will be in place from Friday, February 8, at 9 p.m., to Friday, February 15, at 5 a.m., at the intersection of La Jolla Village Drive and Genesee Avenue. This is the sixth of seven girder installations on Genesee Avenue in the series of closures.

La Jolla Village Drive & Genesee Avenue Intersection:

Weekend closure from 9 p.m. on Friday, February 8, to 5 a.m. on Monday, February 11:

- Closure of southbound Genesee Avenue lanes and through lanes at the La Jolla Village Drive intersection.
- One lane open on northbound Genesee Avenue.

Weekdays from 5 a.m. to 9 p.m. each day:

- Two lanes open on southbound Genesee Avenue.
- Two lanes open on northbound Genesee Avenue.
- Through lanes at La Jolla Village Drive will be closed at Genesee Avenue. Right turns from La Jolla Village Drive to Genesee Avenue will be maintained.

Weeknights from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night:

- Closure of southbound Genesee Avenue lanes and through lanes at the La Jolla Village Drive intersection.
- One lane open on northbound Genesee Avenue.

Traffic controls and detour routes will be posted. Please adhere to the alternate routes when traveling near the work area.

Construction schedules are subject to change.

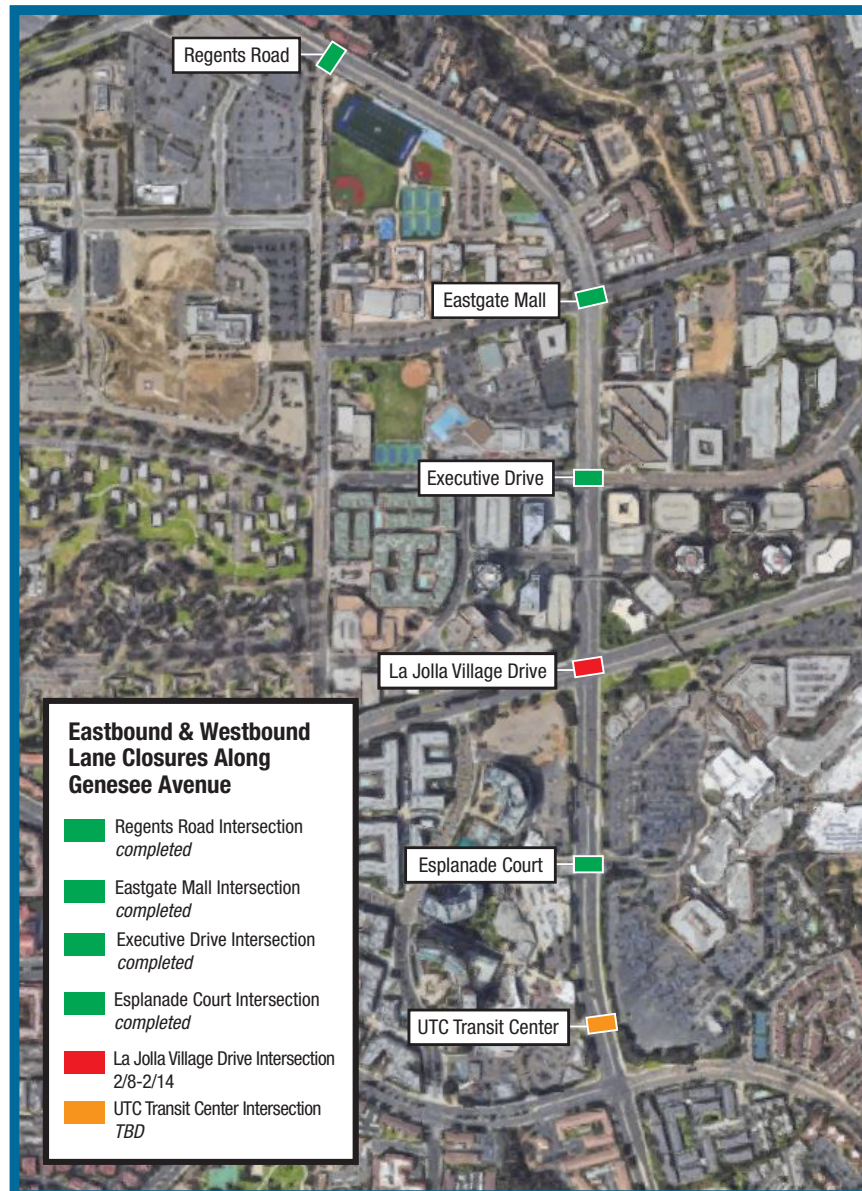


About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend Trolley service from Old Town Transit Center to the University City community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and Westfield UTC. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in 2021.
