MID-COAST TROLLEY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

UPCOMING BALBOA AVENUE/GARNET AVENUE OFF-RAMP CLOSURES AND SIGNALIZATION

As part of the Mid-Coast Trolley project, crews will be signalizing the northbound Interstate 5 off-ramp to Balboa Avenue/Garnet Avenue. To accommodate this work, the following closures and work activities will be in effect on the off-ramp:

- Intermittent, nighttime closures of the northbound Interstate 5 off-ramp to Balboa Avenue/Garnet Avenue starting in December and continuing through summer 2019.
- Installation of a permanent traffic signal at the intersection of the off-ramp and Balboa Avenue/Garnet Avenue. The traffic signal will become operational in early 2019.
- A full weekend closure of the northbound Interstate 5 off-ramp to Balboa Avenue/Garnet Avenue in early 2019.
- Shifting of the northbound Interstate 5 off-ramp to Balboa Avenue/Garnet Avenue to newly constructed pavement adjacent to the existing off-ramp in early 2019.

Construction schedules may change with very little notice.

What to Expect:

- Detour routes and signage will be in place. Please heed all traffic signs and use caution when traveling near the work area.
- Construction activities will include roadway construction work and traffic light installation.
- This work requires the use of heavy machinery and will generate noise. Crews will minimize impacts as much as possible.

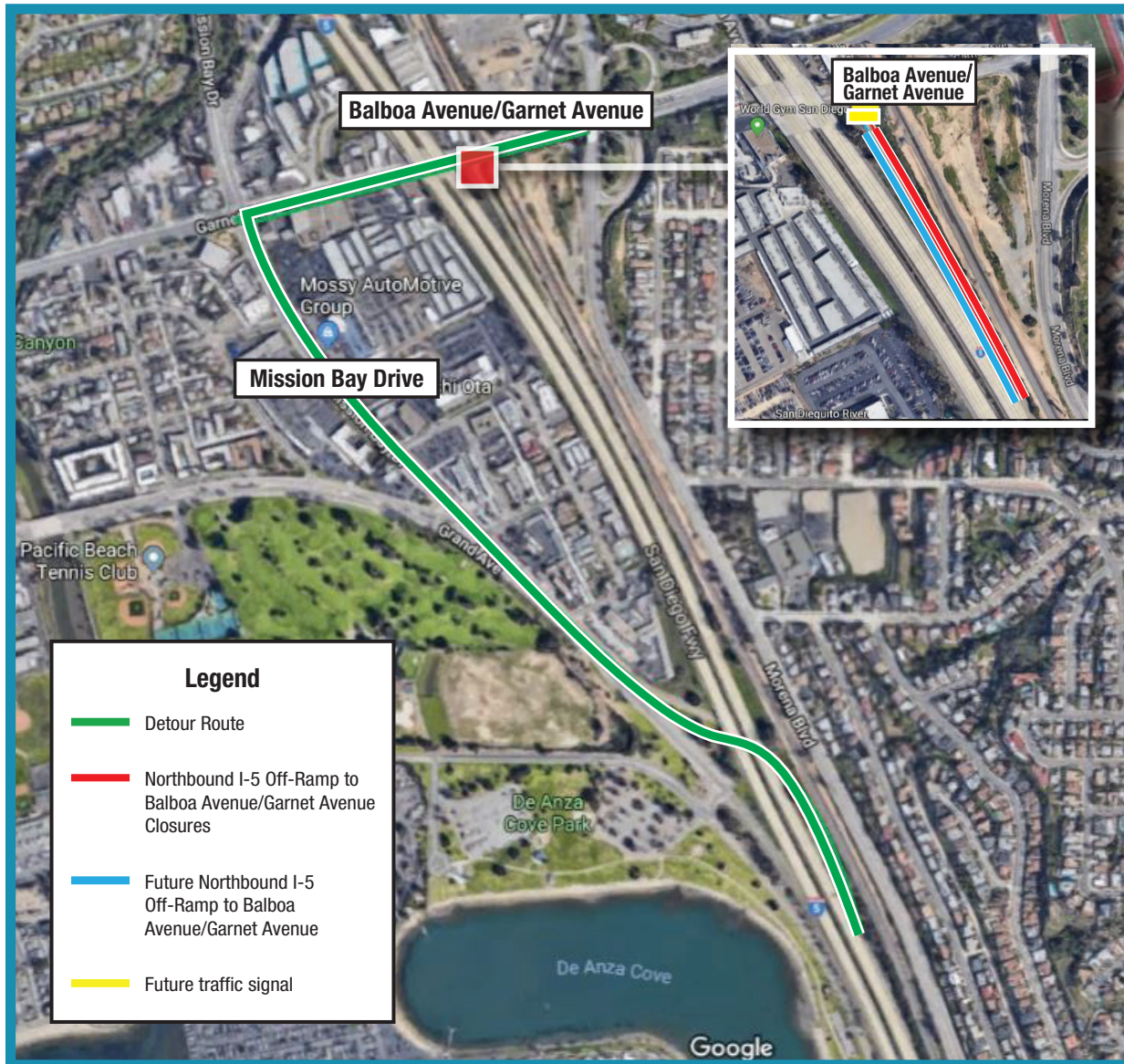

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend Trolley service from Old Town Transit Center to the University City community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and Westfield UTC. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in 2021.
