FRIARS ROAD CLOSURE AND RESTORATION WORK

On Tuesday, January 12, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., a full closure of eastbound and westbound Friars Road will be in place from Sea World Drive to Napa Street. This closure is necessary for crews to perform a traffic switch in preparation for Friars Road restoration work. Motorists will be detoured via Sea World Drive, Tecolote Road, Morena Boulevard, and Napa Street.

Restoration work on Friars Road will continue through the remainder of January. One lane will remain open in each direction while work is underway.

What to Expect

- Additional nighttime full closures may be needed as work continues and notice will be provided beforehand
- Work will include removing k-rail, paving, and restriping Friars Road
- Traffic controls and detour routes will be posted; please heed all traffic signs and use caution when traveling near the area

About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend UC San Diego Blue Line Trolley service from the Santa Fe Depot in Downtown San Diego to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
