



FRIARS ROAD CLOSURE AND RESTORATION WORK

On Tuesday, February 23, an overnight full closure of eastbound and westbound Friars Road will be in place from Sea World Drive to Napa Street. This closure is necessary for crews to restripe the roadway. Motorists will be detoured via Sea World Drive, Tecolote Road, Morena Boulevard, and Napa Street.

Following the restriping activities, Mid-Coast Trolley project construction on Friars Road will be complete and the roadway restored to its original configuration.

What to Expect

- Work and closure hours will be from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Traffic controls and detour routes will be posted; please heed all traffic signs and use caution when traveling near the area

About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend UC San Diego Blue Line Trolley service from the Santa Fe Depot in Downtown San Diego to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
