## LANE CLOSURES AT GENESEE AVENUE AND NOBEL DRIVE INTERSECTION

On Thursday, April 15, there will be overnight lane closures at the intersection of Genesee Avenue and Nobel Drive for paving activities. Northbound, westbound, and eastbound through access will be impacted.

### What to Expect

- Work and closure hours will be 11:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Full closures will be in place on northbound Genesee Avenue from Nobel Drive to Esplanade Court
- Full closures will be in place on eastbound and westbound Nobel Drive between Genesee Avenue and Lombard Place
- As work progresses, lanes may be reopened to accommodate traffic on Genesee Avenue and Nobel Drive
- Please expect noise as this work is completed
- Residential access will be maintained at all times
- Pedestrians should follow signage in the area as some crosswalks will be closed while work is underway
- Please follow signage and use caution when traveling in the area

## Update on Construction During COVID-19 Pandemic

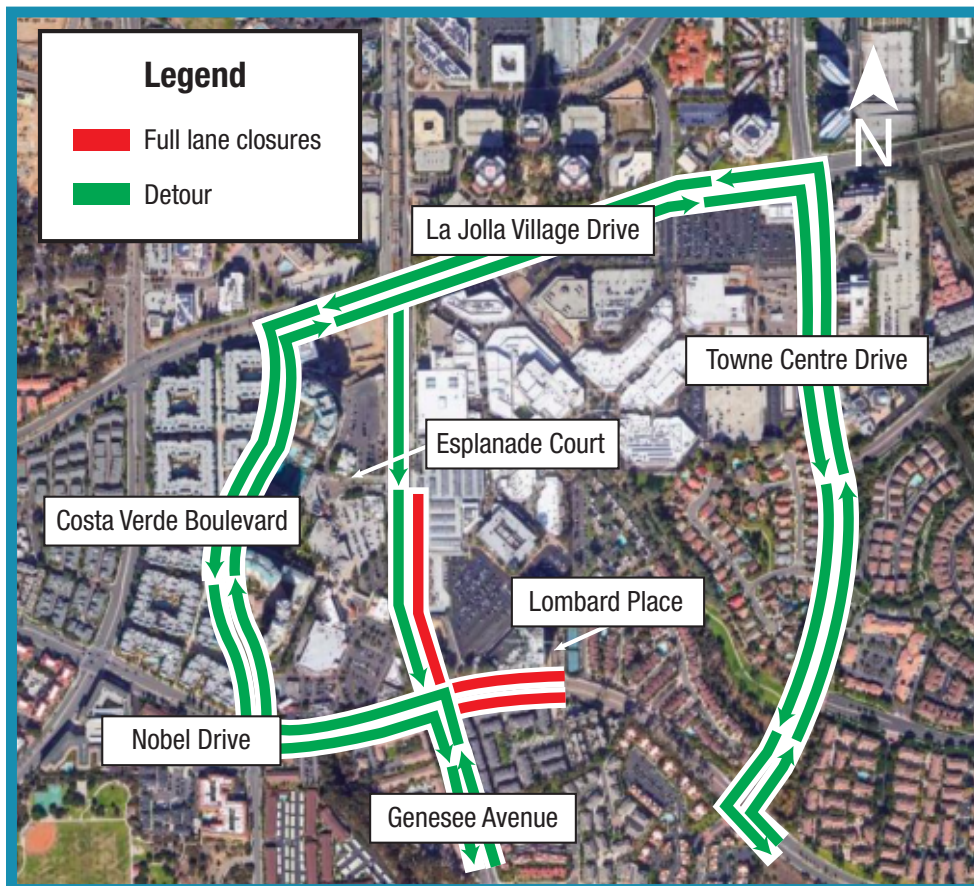

## About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend UC San Diego Blue Line Trolley service from the Santa Fe Depot in Downtown San Diego to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
