



# CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES FOR TROLLEY PARKING STRUCTURE AT LA JOLLA VILLAGE SQUARE

Construction of the Nobel Drive Trolley Station parking structure continues in a section of the La Jolla Village Square parking area and is anticipated to be completed in February 2021. To accommodate the project timeline, construction will continue through the holiday season.

Once complete, the parking structure will be available for use by retail customers while crews continue construction of the Nobel Drive Trolley Station. Crews also will reconfigure the adjacent surface parking lots to provide access to and from the parking structure and improve overall traffic flow. The reconfigurations are anticipated to be completed by October 2021.

When Trolley service begins in late 2021, the parking structure will provide spaces for transit patrons and retail customers and will include a direct walkway to the Nobel Drive Trolley Station.

## What to Expect

- Typical work hours will be Monday through Friday, from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day; occasional weekend work may be required
- Construction activities will include architectural exterior finish work on the structure, elevator installation, striping, painting, and sidewalk and curb installation
- Please expect noise as this work is completed
- Construction activities will take place within or near the fenced work area
- Access to businesses, the mall entrance, and the underground parking garage will be maintained at all times
- To accommodate retail customers during the holiday season, complimentary valet service will be available Friday, November 20, 2020 through January 15, 2021, from 10:30 a.m. to 8 p.m. daily

### **Update on Construction During COVID-19 Pandemic**



#### **About the Mid-Coast Trolley Project**

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend UC San Diego Blue Line Trolley service from the Santa Fe Depot in Downtown San Diego to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
