



# **LANE REDUCTIONS AND BUS SERVICE IMPACTS** ON EASTBOUND BALBOA AVENUE

Beginning Friday, April 9, and continuing for approximately two weeks, lane closures will be in place on eastbound Balboa Avenue for bus pad improvements related to the Mid-Coast Trolley project. Bus pads are durable surface areas, typically made of concrete, used to protect asphalt roadways at bus stops. To accommodate this work, the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System (MTS) bus stop at Balboa Avenue and Moraga Avenue will be temporarily relocated just east of its existing location. Through access on eastbound Balboa Avenue and ramp access from Morena Boulevard will be maintained, though traffic flow may be impacted. Please expect delays when traveling in the area.

#### **What to Expect**

- On Friday, April 9, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., lane closures will be in place on eastbound Balboa Avenue, from the Morena Boulevard overpass to Moraga Avenue
- Beginning Friday, April 9, and continuing through Friday, April 23, MTS bus service at Balboa Avenue and Moraga Avenue will be temporarily relocated just east of the current bus stop
- Beginning Monday, April 12, and continuing for approximately one week, a single lane closure will be in place on eastbound Balboa Avenue for 24 hours a day
- The right-side shoulder on eastbound Balboa Avenue will be closed through Friday, April 23
- Please heed all traffic signs and use caution when traveling near the work area

Construction schedules are subject to change.

### **About the Project**

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend UC San Diego Blue Line Trolley service from the Santa Fe Depot in Downtown San Diego to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
