



MORENA BOULEVARD CLOSURE

Starting Tuesday, April 30, at 9 p.m. and continuing to Wednesday, May 1, at 5 a.m., a full closure of northbound Morena Boulevard will be in place from Ingulf Street to Gesner Street. This closure is necessary to accommodate the delivery of a traction power substation (TPSS), which will provide power for the Trolley. Southbound traffic on Morena Boulevard will not be affected.

Motorists should use Denver Street to detour the work area. Please use extra caution when traveling near the construction activities.

Construction schedules are subject to change with very little notice.

About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend Trolley service from Old Town Transit Center to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
