Upcoming Closure of Nobel Drive

Upcoming Construction on Nobel Drive

Starting Saturday, March 9, through Sunday, March 10, crews will be installing falsework, the temporary structures used to support the Trolley bridge during construction, on Nobel Drive just west of the Interstate 5 (I-5) intersection. A full closure will be in place on Nobel Drive, from the I-5 on-ramp to the entrances of the Shops at La Jolla Village and La Jolla Village Square.

What to Expect

- You may notice increased construction activity, including trucks and heavy equipment, near the entrances of the Shops at La Jolla Village and La Jolla Village Square shopping centers.
- Closure hours begin Saturday morning, March 9, at 12:01 a.m., and will continue through Sunday morning, March 10, at 12:01 a.m.
- Access will be maintained for businesses as well as in-and-out access at the shop entrances at Nobel Drive.

About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend Trolley service from Old Town Transit Center to the University City community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and Westfield UTC. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
