



Upcoming Closure of Nobel Drive

Upcoming Construction on Nobel Drive

Starting Tuesday, May 7, at 10 p.m. and continuing to Wednesday, May 8, at 5 a.m., a full closure will be in place on Nobel Drive from the I-5 off-ramp to the entrances of the Shops at La Jolla Village and La Jolla Village Square. During the closure, crews will pour concrete on the Trolley viaduct, or bridge, above Nobel Drive.

What to Expect

- Closure hours begin Tuesday, May 7, at 10 p.m., and will continue through Wednesday, May 8, at 5 a.m.
- From 7 p.m. to 10 p.m. on Tuesday, lane restrictions on the southbound I-5 on-ramp will be in place. Only one lane will be open on the on-ramp.
- Access will be maintained for businesses as well as in-and-out access at the shop entrances on Nobel Drive.

Construction schedules are subject to change due to weather, equipment, and other issues. Check KeepSanDiegoMoving.com/MidCoast for regular schedule updates.

About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend Trolley service from Old Town Transit Center to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
