## UPCOMING CLOSURE OF NOBEL DRIVE

Starting Wednesday, September 4, a full overnight closure will be in place on Nobel Drive from the Interstate 5 (I-5) off-ramp to the entrances of the Shops at La Jolla Village and La Jolla Village Square. Beginning at 7 p.m. on Wednesday, there will also be a full closure of the southbound I-5 on-ramp from Nobel Drive. During the closure, crews will pour concrete on the Trolley viaduct, or bridge, above Nobel Drive.

### What to Expect

- A full closure of Nobel Drive will be in place from Wednesday, September 4, at 10 p.m. to Thursday, September 5, at 5 a.m.
- A full closure of the southbound I-5 on-ramp from Nobel Drive will be in place from Wednesday, September 4, at 7 p.m. to Thursday, September 5, at 5 a.m.
- In-and-out access to the shop entrances on Nobel Drive will be maintained.

## About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend Trolley service from Old Town Transit Center to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
