



OVERNIGHT CLOSURE OF I-5

On Tuesday, October 8, a full closure of northbound Interstate 5 (I-5) lanes will go into effect as crews pour concrete to form the bridge for the future Trolley overcrossing south of Nobel Drive.

The closure will begin on October 8, and will continue until October 9. Additional freeway closures will be required and notices will be provided at a later date.

Motorists should plan to take alternate routes to avoid potential congestion.

The following closure will be in place:

Beginning Tuesday, October 8, through Wednesday, October 9:

- Full closure of northbound lanes from State Route 52 (SR 52) to La Jolla Village Drive
- Work and closure hours will be from 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Construction schedules are subject to change.

About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend Trolley service from Old Town Transit Center to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.








Work Area:
