MID-COAST TROLLEY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

FULL CLOSURES ON NORTHBOUND PACIFIC HIGHWAY FOR TRANSIT CENTER IMPROVEMENTS

On Saturday, February 27, a full closure will be in place on northbound Pacific Highway for crews to repave the roadway. These activities are part of ongoing improvements for the Old Town Transit Center. Improvements to the transit center and adjacent roadways are being made to prepare for the anticipated increase in Trolley crossings at Taylor Street upon completion of the Mid-Coast Trolley project.

What to Expect

- A full closure will be in place on northbound Pacific Highway from Kurtz Street to the intersection with Taylor Street
- Southbound lanes on Pacific Highway will remain open
- Activities will include demolition work and road repaving
- Work and closure hours will be from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Detour routes and signage will be in place; please use caution when traveling in the area

Construction schedules may change with very little notice.

About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend UC San Diego Blue Line Trolley service from the Santa Fe Depot in Downtown San Diego to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
