



PERMANENT REALIGNMENT OF ROSE CANYON BIKE PATH

Due to forecasted inclement weather conditions, the full closure of the Rose Canyon Bike Path previously scheduled to begin on Tuesday, December 3 has been postponed. The closure has been rescheduled to begin on Monday, December 9, weather permitting. During the closure, crews will pave the final section of the new and improved bike path.

What to Expect

- The bike path full closure will begin at 6 a.m. on Monday, December 9, and will be in place for approximately five days. The bike path is anticipated to reopen by 6 p.m. on Friday, December 13.
- Mid-Coast Trolley crews will facilitate a "bus bridge," which will include bicycle-carrying capable vans, to transport cyclists and pedestrians around the closure area. The bus bridge will be available from 5 a.m. to 8 p.m. each day, and signage will be in place to designate the pick-up locations.
- During the closure, crews will remove the temporary ramp currently in place between Gilman Drive and State Route 52 (SR 52).
- Please use caution when traveling near the area.
