MID-COAST TROLLEY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

ONGOING LANE CLOSURES ON PACIFIC HIGHWAY, TAYLOR STREET, AND ROSECRANS STREET FOR TRANSIT IMPROVEMENTS

Beginning late February 2020 and continuing through summer 2021, intermittent lane closures and sidewalk closures will be in place on Pacific Highway, Taylor Street, and Rosecrans Street for transit related improvements. Crews will reconfigure Pacific Highway and Taylor Street in preparation for the anticipated increase in Trolley crossings at Taylor Street upon completion of the Mid-Coast Trolley project. Additionally, crews will make improvements to the Old Town Transit Center and the adjacent Park & Ride.

Beginning Sunday, March 1, and continuing for approximately six weeks, a section of Pacific Highway will be reduced to one through lane at the intersection at Taylor Street. Turn lanes will not be impacted. The lane reductions will continue intermittently while improvements are underway and additional notice will be provided beforehand.

What to Expect

- Activities will include demolition work, road widening, and the construction of new bus passenger platforms along Pacific Highway, Taylor Street, and Rosecrans Street.
- Both daytime and nighttime work will be required. Daytime work hours will be from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Nighttime work hours will be from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Please use caution when traveling in the area and follow signage.

Construction schedules may change with very little notice.

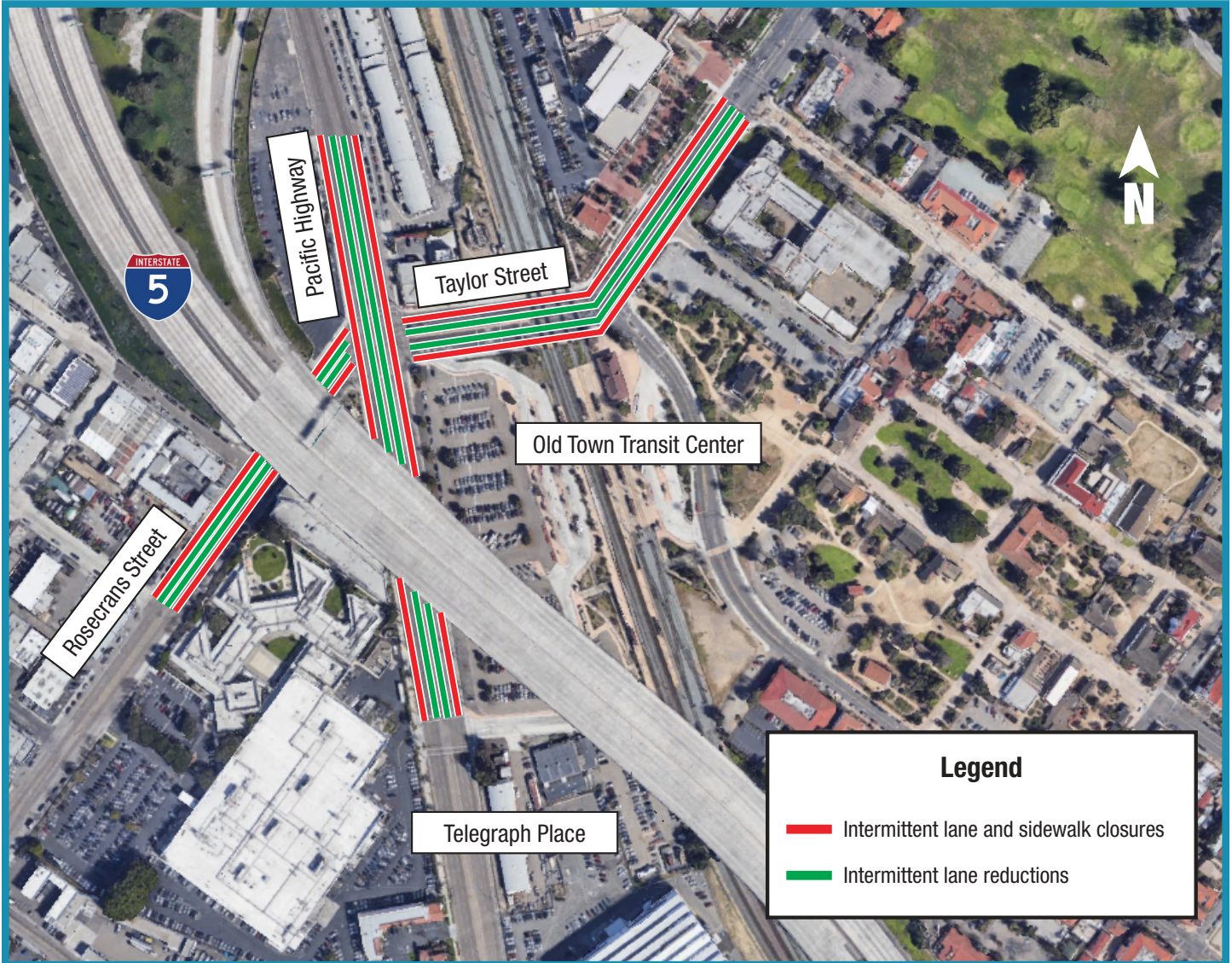

About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend UC San Diego Blue Line Trolley service from the Santa Fe Depot in Downtown San Diego to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
