



CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES FOR TROLLEY PARKING STRUCTURE AT UNIVERSITY TOWNE CENTRE

In early February, construction activities for the UTC Transit Center parking structure will begin in a section of the surface parking area at University Towne Centre, near Macy's. Crews will install a fence to designate the construction area and then conduct grading and excavation work.

The parking structure is being constructed concurrently with the future Trolley station at the UTC Transit Center. When Trolley service begins in late 2021, the structure will provide spaces for transit patrons and retail customers. Construction of the parking structure will continue throughout this year and is anticipated to be completed in November 2021.

What to Expect:

- Typical work hours will be Mondays through Fridays, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day
- Ongoing general construction activities will include grading, excavation work, and concrete placement
- Crews will minimize impacts as much as possible; notice will be provided beforehand if construction activities are anticipated to create noise impacts to the nearby community

Construction schedules are subject to change.




About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend UC San Diego Blue Line Trolley service from the Santa Fe Depot in Downtown San Diego to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
