UPCOMING CLOSURE OF VEGA STREET

Beginning Monday, November 30, crews will demolish and reconstruct Vega Street, to improve access to the future Tecolote Road Trolley Station. To accommodate this work, a full closure of Vega Street is necessary and will be in place for approximately three weeks.

What to Expect

- Full closure of Vega Street from the intersection at W. Morena Boulevard and continuing southwest to its terminus
- Typical work hours will be Mondays through Fridays, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day; occasional weekend or nightwork may be required
- Work activities will include demolition, excavation, installing new curbs, paving, and making traffic signal modifications
- Demolition activities, back up alarms, and vibratory rollers will be present at times, so please expect noise; crews will minimize impacts as much as possible
- Signage will be in place; please heed all traffic signs and use caution when traveling near the work area
- Access to the nearby businesses will be maintained

Construction schedules are subject to change.

About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend UC San Diego Blue Line Trolley service from the Santa Fe Depot in Downtown San Diego to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
