- 11-mile extension of Trolley Blue Line
- Old Town Transit Center to Westfield UTC
- Nine new stations (five with parking)

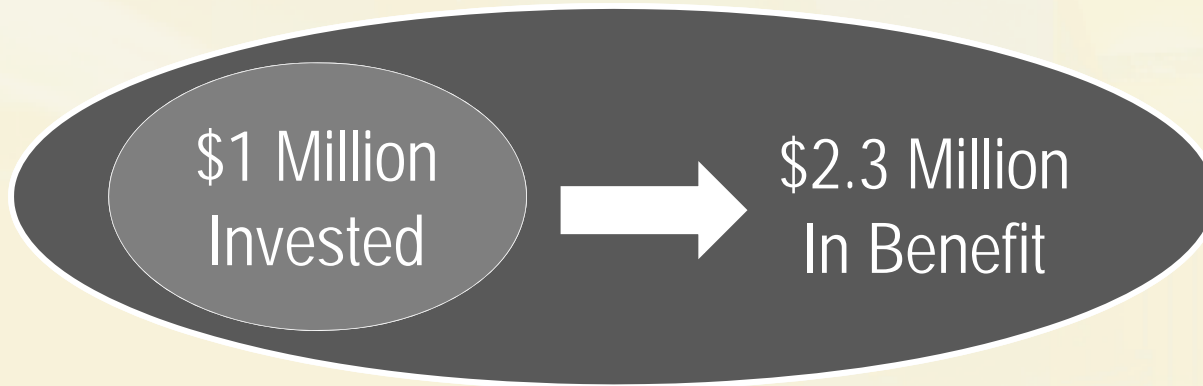

Benefits to Economy and Environment



Reduces

When service begins



- 21,000 new daily boardings north of Old Town
- 15 minute headways on opening day; 7.5 minute headways in 2030
- Service coordinated with buses at transit centers
- Barrier free system – roving fare inspectors and security
- All stations and parking areas will have CCTV and PA system

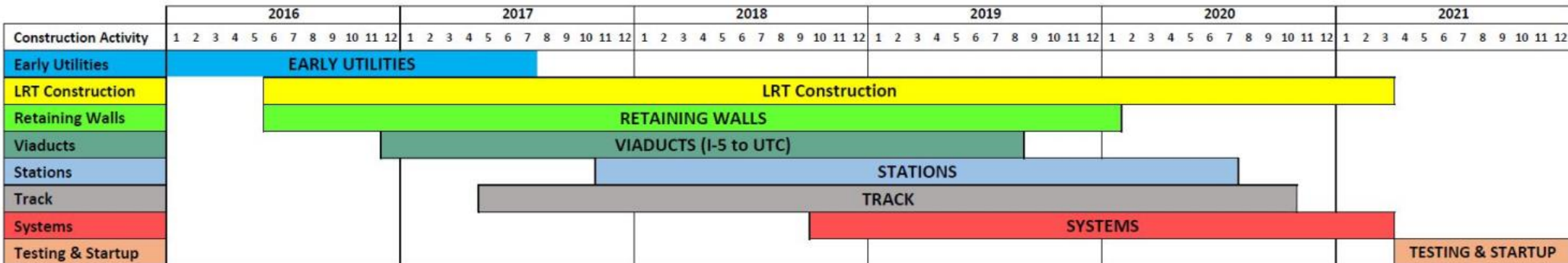

- Construction hours generally M-F, 7 a.m.– 5 p.m.
- Night and weekend work where needed
 - Genesee Ave. mostly night/weekend work
- Right-of-way acquisition in process
- Traffic Management Plans
- Noise permit
- Dust mitigation

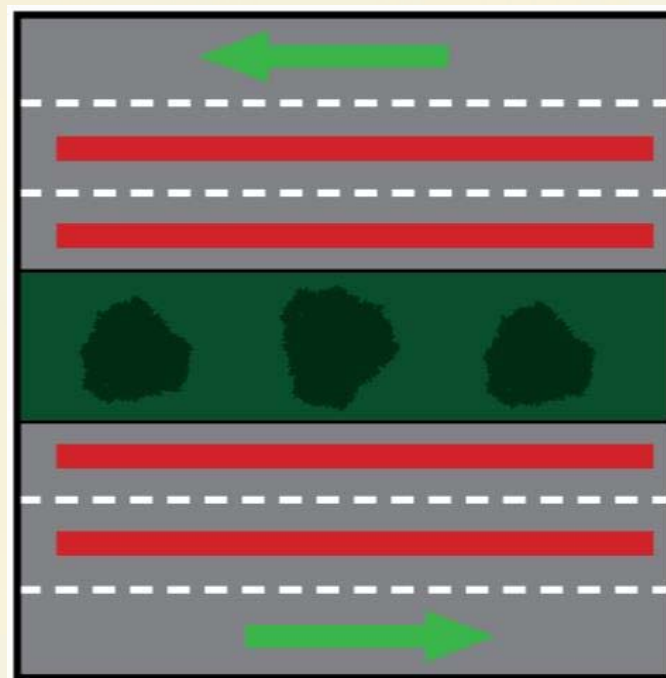

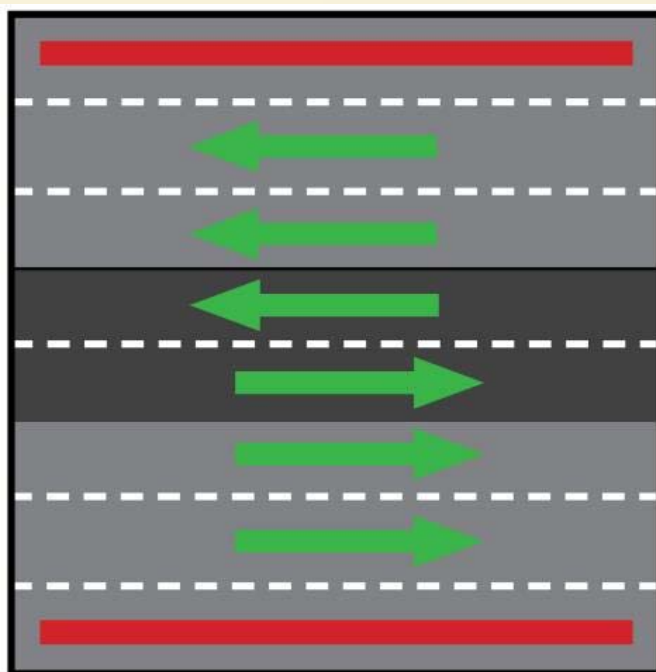

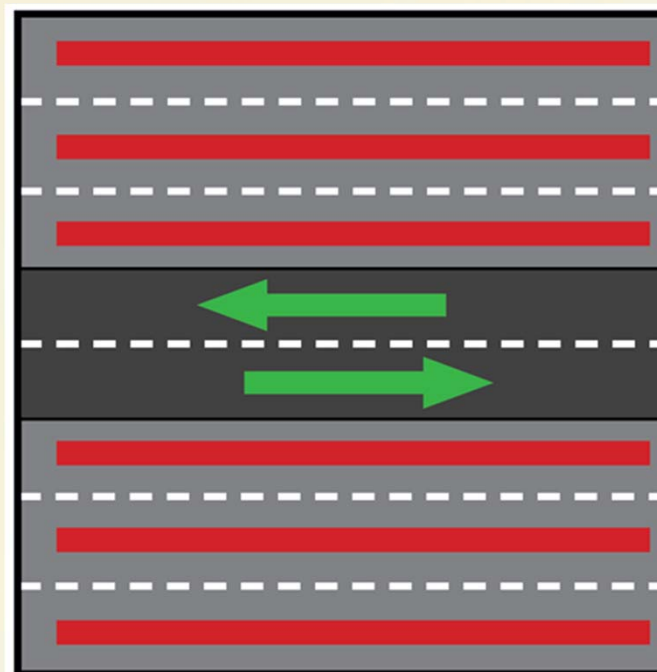

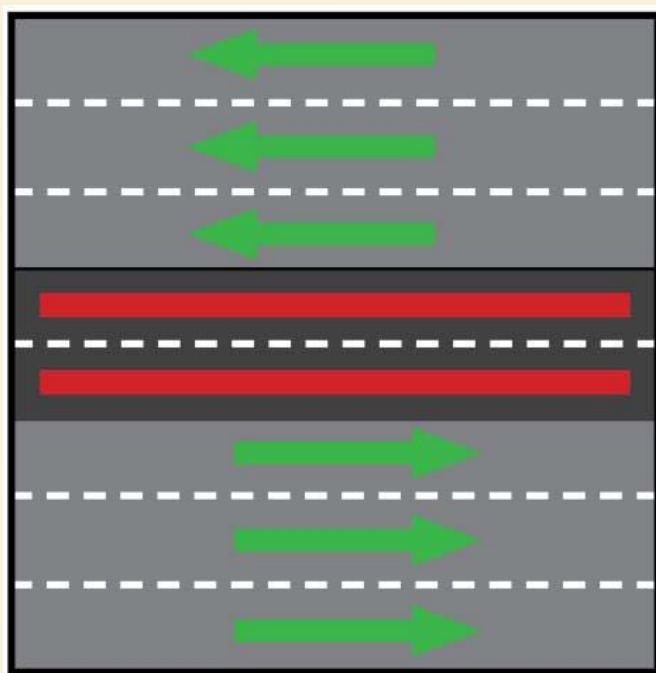

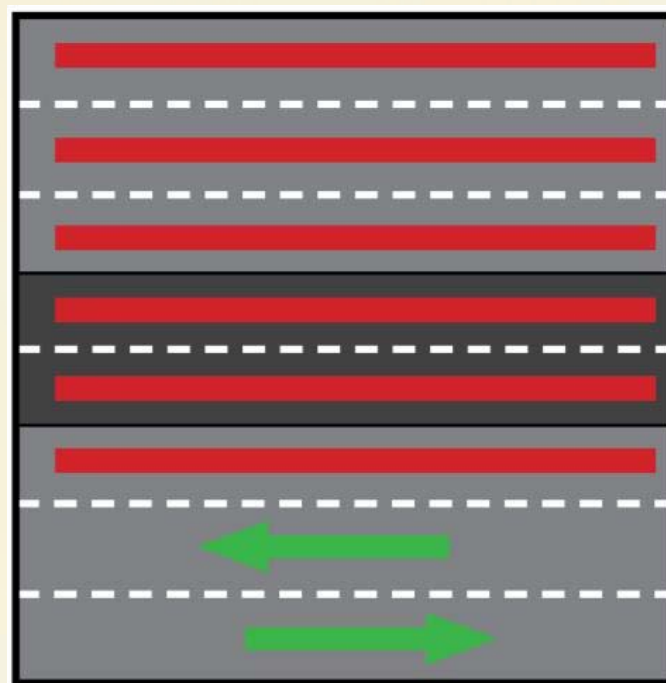
