



MISSION BAY DRIVE LANE REDUCTIONS

Starting the week of October 15, and lasting approximately two weeks, there will be lane reductions and traffic controls in place on southbound Mission Bay Drive, near the intersection of Damon Street while construction crews pour concrete for a portion of the bike path slab for the Rose Creek Bikeway. The following nighttime traffic controls will be in effect on Mission Bay Drive:

- Northbound Mission Bay Drive will be reduced to one lane.
- Southbound Mission Bay Drive will be reduced to one lane.

What to Expect

- Work hours will be during the night, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Construction activities will include setting the concrete pump and pouring concrete. Construction vehicles will also be active and present in the area. Please expect some noise.
- Flaggers will be in place to help direct traffic. Please use extra caution when traveling near the work area and remain aware of travel speed.

Construction schedules are subject to change with very little notice.

About the Project

The Rose Creek Bikeway is part of the Coastal Rail Trail and is a Class I bike path (completely separated from vehicle traffic). It connects existing sections of the Rose Canyon and Rose Creek bike paths in the City of San Diego.


The bikeway will begin at the north end of Santa Fe Street and connect to the existing bike path at Damon Street and Mission Bay Drive.
