



Noise Alert Near Regents Road

This fall, crews will be constructing a maintenance vehicle access road turnaround in the canyon south of Regents Road. Work is scheduled from the night of Tuesday, October 16, through Monday, October 22, with possible intermittent work through Wednesday, November 14. Although the work will be in the canyon, construction crews will be using Regents Road to access, store, and transfer equipment and materials to the work site.

What to Expect

- Nighttime work hours are from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. for the week of Tuesday, October 16 through Monday, October 22. The remaining work will take place from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Construction activities include grading and installing storm drains in the canyon. Crews will be using the entrance at Regents Road to travel to and from the work site.
- Heavy construction equipment such as excavators, loaders and trucks will be present.
- Please expect some noise.

Crews will minimize noise impacts to the extent possible.

Please use caution if traveling near the area. Construction schedules are subject to change with very little notice.

















About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend Trolley service from Old Town Transit Center to the University City community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and Westfield UTC. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in 2021.
