SANTA FE STREET TRAFFIC SHIFT AND PARKING CHANGES

On Monday, October 19, a traffic shift will be in place on Santa Fe Street as crews restripe the roadway between Karl Strauss Brewing Company and Coventry Cars of San Diego, to accommodate construction of the Rose Creek Bikeway. Following the traffic shift, Santa Fe Street will be in its final alignment and street parking on the west side of Santa Fe Street will be removed permanently.

What to Expect:

- Work hours will be from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- During the construction activities, traffic access will remain open on Santa Fe Street and flaggers will be present
- Street parking will be removed permanently on the west side of Santa Fe Street, between 5985 and 5097 Santa Fe Street; signage will be in place to alert motorists
- Please follow all posted signage carefully during these times
- Crews will minimize impacts as much as possible
- Access to properties will be maintained

About the Project

The Rose Creek Bikeway is part of the Coastal Rail Trail and is a Class I bike path (completely separated from vehicle traffic). It connects existing sections of the Rose Canyon and Rose Creek bike paths in the City of San Diego.

The bikeway will begin at the north end of Santa Fe Street and connect to the existing Rose Creek Bike Path at the intersection of Damon Street and Mission Bay Drive.
